Scientists for Cycling

The meeting in the Protestant Academy Bad Boll is the first meeting linked to the ECF network Scientists for Cycling. It is open for all who are interested in the theme cycling and science. At the meeting the participants will discuss and develop some general themes, issues and questions scientists should consider when they do research, publish and speak at conferences. Some invited high level speakers will give short statements and key-questions from their professional perspective, to set the tone for the interdisciplinary debate.

One of ECF's objectives is to spot interesting themes and speakers for the ECF Velo-city conference series.(*)

At the Bad Boll meeting a secondary theme will be explored: Cycling, time and space. How do we experience time and space in our daily life? What do philosophers and psychologists for example, tell us about this? Should we address people with the story of cycling the fastest way to move in the city' or show them the concept of slow mobility? What kind of relevant facts & figures do we need from science about e.g. cycling time and space.

The following scientists and high-level experts will open the discussions:

Manfred Neun, ECF president – will open the discussion with key words and questions about global cycling visions with a short term perspective for a more sustainable world (opening speech)

Prof. Barbara Adams, University of Cardiff – time theory and socio-environmental theory (invited)

Jörg Schindler, Board member Energy Watch Group and ASPO, Munich – peak oil and post-fossil energy use

Dr. Bernhard Ensink, ECF Secretary General and Velo-City Series Director – some more questions about a cycling friendly future (closing remarks) and others.
