## The Christian Understanding of Human Rights

After the appalling experiences of World War II, the countries of the United Nations came together on December 10, 1948 and agreed on the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. At the core of this declaration is the foundation of Human Rights on respect for the dignity and the value of each person. Human rights are therefore regarded as universal, inalienable and indivisible.

From a Christian understanding, human dignity and human value are based on the Covenant of God's faithfulness to his people, as well as of his love for the world. In the light of this Covenant the churches get involved when human dignity is trampled on and when fundamental rights are disregarded. In acting so, the churches are motivated by the firm conviction that the entire "oikoumene", the whole inhabited earth is destined to live in the peace of the Lord according to God's plan of Salvation.

Nevertheless the ecumenical dialogue in recent years showed some diverse positions on the understanding and application of the human rights concept. This is a dialogue that is also influenced by different theological and cultural approaches. The conference in Bad Boll will provide an opportunity for an ecumenical exchange on the Christian understanding of Human rights. It shall as well pave the way for joint activities of the churches in Europe to protect human dignity and human value in the challenges of today's world.

The Conference will provide the opportunity to participate in the farewell service for Rev. Prof. h. c. Manfred Wagner in Reutlingen on Saturday.
